

**Lewiston City Council**  
**Emergency Council Meeting Minutes**  
**August 31, 2020**  
**Lewiston City Hall – 6:00 P.M.**

**1. Call to Order**

Electronic Emergency City Council Meeting called to order by Mayor Beth Carlson at 6:00 pm August 31, 2020.

**2. Roll Call**

Present (4): Mayor Beth Carlson, Councilor Dan Robertson, Councilor Carol Boynton, and Councilor Larry Rupprecht. Not Present (1): Councilor Niles Lavey.

Others present: City Administrator/Clerk Cheryl Knight.

**3. Agenda**

Mayor Carlson asked if everyone had received the email information sent out regarding the blower needed at the wastewater treatment plant? Councilor Boynton had not due to an Internet outage by CenturyLink. City Administrator/Clerk Cheryl Knight stated an e-mail from James Creaghe of PeopleService was received that a blower for the retention basin had quit working and is the only air for the tank mixing. It was labeled as an essential system need. It could tentatively be installed on Thursday. If not approved today, installation would not be completed until after the holiday (the upcoming Labor Day Holiday). Having this blower not work with no mixing for that length of time would be detrimental to the system. Both General Repair Service (for the blower removal and installation of \$2,640.00) and GPM (for a 68 URAI for \$5,077.85) will honor their July 2020 quotes from a previous blower. Knight stated that funds would come from the sewer fund, 602-49450-400.

Councilor Robertson motioned for approval of the expense as quoted in the amount of \$7,717.85 to purchase and install a blower at the wastewater treatment plant. Seconded by Councilor Boynton.

Approved 4-0.

Councilor Rupprecht motioned to adjourn the City Council meeting. Seconded by Councilor Boynton.
